Only one (1) night stays are permitted unless approved in writing by the manager or designee. Advance reservations are preferred. If arriving after hours, please leave payment and signed forms in an envelope and place in the office mailbox or at the maintenance shop.

Fees: \$20.00 per night/per stall – includes one bag of shavings and stall cleaning. Cash or check only payable in advance to: Mesa County Fairgrounds. Shavings are required. If you have brought your own bedding, the overnight fee is reduced to \$15.00 per stall.

All animals are left on property at their own risk. There is no overnight security on the premises. Locking the stall doors is not permitted by order of the Fire Marshall.

By signing below licensee acknowledges and assumes responsibility of themselves, their guests, and their animals against injury or mishap and further indemnifies Mesa County for any liability thereof.

By signing below, licensee acknowledges that any animals left on the Fairgrounds property are in good health and pose no health threat to any other livestock.
