LICENSOR FEES, POLCIES, AND PROCEDURES FOR OVERNIGHT BOARDING

By signing this license, all overnight boarders agree to the terms listed below:

1. All overnight boarders must complete and sign the Fairgrounds Liability Waiver.
2. Only one (1) night stays are permitted unless approved in writing by the manager or designee. Advanced reservations are preferred. If arriving afterhours, please leave payment and signed forms in an envelope and place in the Fairgrounds Office mailbox or at the Maintenance Shop.
3. **Fees:** Stalls are \$25.00 per night, per stall. This fees includes a single bag of shavings and one stall cleaning. Cash or check should be paid in advance to: Mesa County Fairgrounds. Shavings are required. If you have brought your own bedding, the fee is reduced to \$15 per stall.
4. All animals are left on property at their own risk. There is no overnight security on the premises. Locking the stall doors are not permitted by order of the Fire Marshall.
5. **EQUINE AND LLAMA LAW:** *“WARNING: Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.” AND “WARNING: Under Colorado Law, a llama professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in llama activities resulting from the inherent risks of llama activities, pursuant to section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.”*

By signing below Licensee acknowledges and assumes responsibility of themselves, their guests, and their animals against injury or mishap and further indemnifies Mesa County for any liability thereof.

By signing below, Licensee acknowledges that any animal left on the Fairgrounds property are in good health and pose no health risk to any other livestock.
