

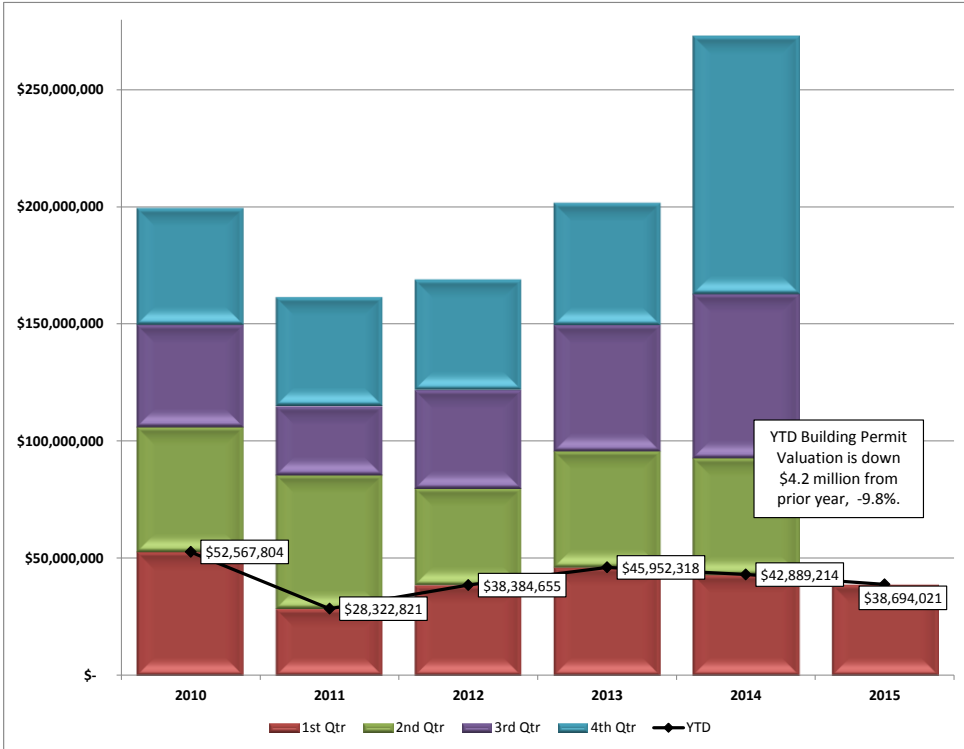
# Mesa County Building Permits
