R E S O L U T I O N

ADOPTING THE AIR QUALITY MAINTENANCE PLAN FOR TOTAL SUSPENDED PARTICULATES AND SCHEDULES FOR ATTAINMENT AND MAINTENANCE IN THE GRAND JUNCTION AREA.

WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1977, P.L. 95-95 require that, for areas in which National Ambient Air Quality Standards have not been attained, implementation plan revisions be prepared for attainment and maintenance of these standards; and

WHEREAS, portions of the Grand Junction non-attainment area currently exceed the National Standards for particulates and are not expected to meet the standards by the deadline set forth in Section 172 of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1977; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1977 specify that, when feasible, the revised implementation plan shall be prepared; and

WHEREAS, the Grand Junction Area Air Quality Advisory Committee has, in coordination with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Colorado Air Pollution Control Commission, the City of Grand Junction and the Colorado Department of Health, and other local agencies, prepared a plan based on the best reasonably available control measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MESA:

That the control measures be administered and enforced locally, and that the Board of County Commissioners of Mesa County supports and will continue to support the requirements of the Clean Air Act Amendment of 1977, P.L. 95-95, in a fiscal manner by the as-needed allocation of manpower and financial resources as available for the attainment and maintenance of ambient air quality; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Mesa County adopts the Air Quality Maintenance Plan for Total Suspended Particulates and the attached schedule of


