

ORDINANCE NO. 5

REGULATING THE TRANSPORTING OF WASTE OR DISCARDED MATERIALS ON THE HIGHWAYS IN MESA COUNTY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the manner of transporting waste and discarded materials over the highways in the County of Mesa has become of major concern affecting the public peace, health and safety; and

WHEREAS, that transporting now needs to be regulated under the provisions of 30-15-401(1)(a)(III) and 30-15-401(1)(a)(V), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1973, as amended;

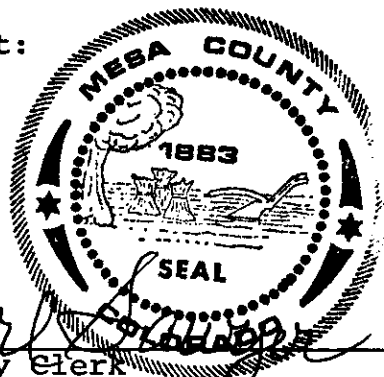
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MESA, COLORADO:

1. No vehicle containing ashes, trash, waste, rubbish, garbage, industrial waste products or discarded materials shall be driven or moved on any highway unless the load is within a covered vehicle or unless the load itself is covered.

2. Any person violating this Ordinance commits a class 2 petty offense and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars for each separate violation.
