The pertinent features of this project will include engineering, geotechnical investigation and design for upsizing and replacement of an existing French drain located on the south side of I road. The purpose of this structure is to keep water from running onto structures located south of I Road. The current structure is no longer functioning as designed and needs to be replaced and upgraded.

The County reserves the right to accept or reject any portion of the proposals or the entire proposals without disclosing the reason therefore.
