The Public Works Department of Mesa County is requesting Statements of Qualifications from Consultants interested in performing the necessary tasks develop detailed construction documents The intent of the Orchard Avenue Corridor Study project is to provide investigation, analysis, and design of the project area on Orchard Avenue (E ½ Road) from 29 ½ Road to Warrior Way in order to prepare a detailed corridor study and preliminary 30% design of the projected improvements.

The successful offeror must be prepared to perform all services required by the County as outlined in Section II and III of the Request for Qualifications. The submittals will be evaluated by Mesa County Public Works staff. It is the County's goal to select a consultant who will provide the highest quality of customer service, design and project management. The award of the contract will be based on the evaluation criteria outlined in Section IV of the Request for Qualifications.
