



**Special Waste Management Plan
Waste Characterization Data
Generator Instructions**

Step 1

Complete Section I of the attached Waste Characterization Data Packet. Fax or mail Section I information to the Hazardous Materials Manager (HMM) or the Regulatory Compliance Manager (CM) for review. Contact information for the HMM/CM is as follows:

Step 2

If the waste in question requires analytical testing, complete Section II of the packet. Section II will include a general schematic sample plan to be reviewed by the HMM/CM. Include the number of samples to be taken (grab or composite), as well as the depth and distance between grab samples. Contact the HMM/CM for sample plan approval and basic analytical testing requirements.

Step 3

If necessary, the HMM/CM may adjust sampling plan procedures and analytical testing requirements between the generator and the landfill. The HMM/CM will contact the generator with modifications.

Step 4

Return the completed Waste Characterization Data packet Sections I and II, along with the analytical results to the HMM/CM for final review. Please allow a minimum of one week for this review.

Step 5

Subsequent to review, the HMM/CM will return a Letter of Acceptance or Rejection to the generator.

Step 6

If the generator receives an acceptance letter from the HMM/CM, the generator may contact the Landfill Contractor or CM to schedule a date and time for acceptance of the material within the Mesa County Landfill. Contact information for the Landfill Contractor is as follows:
